




































TECHNICAL DRAWING, INLET SYSTEM & DRAINAGE SYSTEM










INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION


Step 1

Insert the drainage pipe into the drainage hole on the wall.




Step 2


Remove the upper cover, pull up the braid tube until it gets off the hanger.




Step 3


- **a.** Lean the whole cistern to the wall and align the flush pipe position with the buckle.
- **b.** As indicated by the arrows, mark the 4 spots on the wall and 2 spots on the ground accordingly.





- **c.** Move off cistern first.
- d. Drill the holes according to the marked spots (the depth of the drill must be larger than the length of the expansion nut, the diameter shown as in the picture) and press the corresponding expansion nut into the hole.








e: Lean the whole frame onto the right position of the wall.


f: Look the corresponding size of the screws into the expansion nut in the wall and steel expansion bolt on the floor.



Step 4


a: Buckle the braid tube onto the hanger again, and connect the tube to the angle valve on the wall.

b: Open the stop valve on the hose to see whether it is in good condition.




Step 5


Mark: All batteries should be AAA batteries, and please do not mix old and new batteries when using.








Install the glass onto the aluminum frame and push downward the glass support buckle until the buckles lock with pendant on the aluminum frame.






Assemble the top cover back to the cistern frame.






a: Draw line on the straight flush pipe and drain pipe.





d: Apply silicone oil.






a: Screw the bolts into the cistern frame.

b: Install toilet mat.



c: Install the flush pipe onto the cistern.


d: Install the flush pipe onto the toilet.




e: Install toilet.

Note: Toilet installation is for reference only. Actual installation should follow the toilet and its instruction.

f: Cut off extra part of the toilet mat.



g: Sensor area: wave your hand within around 50 mm from the top cover to test the function of half& full flush.






MAINTENANCE & DAILY CARE

Step 1


Inlet valve removal

a: Remove the top cover and unplug the mating parts.

b: Turn off the stop valve on the flexible hose.




- c: Disconnect hose and the valve.
- d: Take off the inlet valve upwards.






Inlet valve adjustment & clean

a: Adjust the float upwards to increase the inlet volume; or downwards to reduce the volume.




- b: Remove the water-stopping part.
- c: Wash this removed part.







Flush valve removal


a: Disconnect the air hoses from the air hose holes.


b: Remove the lever.



c: Lift upwards the flush valve after opening the buckles on the cistern hunger.











Flush valve adjustment & clean

a: Adjust the float upwards to reduce the flush volume; or downwards to increase the volume.









Flush valve installation

a: Install the flush valve downwards into the cistern body (Mark: make sure the flush valve bottom is aligned with flush valve base. And please make sure flush valve is installed in the shown direction during installation.)



b: Press the flush valve until it clicks in the correct position.

c: Re-install the lever.



d: Re-install the top glass cover.
